RESTORE REFRESH DAY

Make a difference. Build community. Refresh spaces that support affordable homeownership.

Corporate teams, community groups, and youth groups are invited to join us for a hands-on volunteer experience at the Guelph or Fergus ReStore. Each experience accommodates up to 10 participants and supports Habitat for Humanity's mission to help more families achieve safe, affordable homeownership. ReStore ReFresh days are available for up to 10 participants at \$5,000/day.

RePaint

Both of our ReStore locations are ready for a fresh coat of paint, and with so much wall space, we need all hands on deck!

Your team will help brighten and transform the retail environment for shoppers, donors, staff, and volunteers. There's also an opportunity to paint a Habitat mural!

ReBuild

Help us create functional, uplifting staff areas that support the well-being and productivity of our volunteers and employees. Your team may assist with flooring, light carpentry, painting and designing. This project helps us create welcoming, efficient spaces for the people who keep our ReStores running every day.

ReOrg

Calling all organization experts! Our ReStores need your help bringing structure, clarity, and flow to key areas such as the warehouse, retail floor space, storage rooms, and administration spaces. Your group will apply real organizing skills to make our stores safer, more efficient, and more customer and staff friendly.

ReStores support affordable housing through circular impact.

Habitat ReStores generate over \$2 million annually to fund affordable housing while diverting significant volumes of building materials and household goods from landfill, advancing circular economy outcomes in our community.

Inspire the Next Generation of Skilled Trades Professionals

Invest in the future of skilled trades by sponsoring a Habitat Build Day. Partner with a local high school carpentry class to give students hands-on construction experience while supporting affordable homeownership in Guelph and Wellington County.
